Notes:

Solid yellow line: Boundary of natural feature S20, woodlot (Dillon, 1999)

Solid orange line: Boundary of natural heritage system feature, woodland, Schedule L3, City of Ottawa Official Plan 2014. It encompasses S20, an extension to northeast, both within the urban expansion area, and S23 a rural natural feature outside the expansion area.

Solid red rectangle: Area of clear cut along CN abandoned rail line

Solid red ellipse: Area of tree cutting within the natural heritage system feature

Solid red line: Boundary of the North Kanata Urban Expansion Area

Dotted orange line: Property line between 936 March Road (Metcalfe) and 1020 March Rd (Valecraft). S20, and by extension the natural heritage system feature of which it is part, straddles the two properties, known as 1b and 1c in the Official Plan, OPA76.

Dotted yellow line: Boundary of vegetation communities: 3) cultural woodland, 7) moist cedar forest, 9) mixed ash and cedar forest, 10) poplar forest, 11) ash forest
