City officials have been playing down or denying they know anything about the gigantic [Walton International](#) proposed [development](#) in southwest Ottawa.

In fact, Walton in its February 2013 newsletter says differently:

In September 2012, the [Ontario](#) Municipal Board ruled that a total of 2,725 acres of land will be added to the Ottawa urban area. Currently, Walton is actively participating in the 2014 Official Plan Review Process to advocate for all Walton-managed lands in Ottawa to be included as part of the future growth area. As we plan our lands in the Ottawa region to their highest and best uses, we anticipate they will become more attractive to end-users, potentially resulting in sales to end-users and, ultimately, distributions back to our investors.
