CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

February 2019

Dear Resident/Business Owner,

The Kanata South Link (KSL) project is scheduled to start construction on **Tuesday, February 19, 2019**. The main objective of the project is to improve safety and traffic flow based on growing demands in the area.

Every effort is being made to reduce impacts of construction in your community. The City of Ottawa is committed to keeping the community informed about this project as it progresses.

Who: The Contractor, **Cavanagh Construction Ltd.**, will be performing the construction work for the City of Ottawa.

Why: The purpose of this project is to widen Old Richmond Road and a portion of West Hunt Club Road to improve traffic capacity across the Greenbelt from Kanata South.

What: The project includes:

- the widening of Old Richmond Road from Hope Side Road to West Hunt Club Road, and West Hunt Club Road from Old Richmond Road to approximately 200 metres east of Moodie Drive
- roundabouts at three intersections along Old Richmond Road: at Hope Side Road; at Stonehaven Drive; and at West Hunt Club Road
- Intersection improvements at West Hunt Club Road and Moodie Drive
- Asphalt resurfacing of Hope Side Road
- Utility upgrades including street lighting

When: Construction is planned to begin in February 2019, with completion by late 2020, and is expected to include a 2019-2020 winter shutdown period.

Utility relocations will take place over the winter 2019. This includes fencing, signage and significant tree removal along the road corridor to accommodate the road construction.

Where: Construction will take place on the following roads:

- Old Richmond Road (Hope Side Road to West Hunt Club Road including roundabouts at three intersections)
- West Hunt Club Road (Old Richmond Road to approximately 200 metres east of Moodie Drive)
- Hope Side Road (Old Richmond Road to Freeport Drive)
